

Sioux Rivers Mental Health Hospital Emergency Evaluation Procedure

To be followed when individuals are voluntary or involuntarily placed in a hospital emergency room for medical clearance and referral.

Individual presents at local ER for a Mental Health Emergency without Court involvement



Individual presents at local ER for a Mental Health Emergency with initial Court involvement.



Hospital:

1. Completes the Sioux Rivers MHDS short application and/or demographics sheet and emails completed application/demographics sheet to Service Coordinator
2. Attempts to get a CSN release of information (ROI) and emails signed ROI to the Service Coordinator. If CSN release was not able to be obtained inform Service Coordinator of no signature.
3. Contacts Flow State to complete an evaluation through the Flow State contact procedures. (Via email, page, text, phone call)



Flow State:
Completes evaluation per Flow State policy and informs hospital of recommendations and send note to "Sue"



Recommendations Mental Health Emergency without Court involvement



Hospital:

- Contact Service Coordinator for **pre-approval** for regional funding transportation through completion of the transportation request form. (See policy)

Service Coordinator:

- Work with individual to complete full application and coordinate any reasonable on-going services per eligibility requirements.

Recommendations Mental Health Initial Court Involvement

Hospital:

- File Physician Report of Examination and submit to court for the mental health hearing.



Outpatient Setting to include Crisis Stabilization chairs and beds (individual needs to be willing)



Inpatient



Hospital:

- Comply with Court Order for Transportation for inpatient services.
- Contact Service Coordinator with evaluation recommendations and outcomes.

Service Coordinator:

- Work with individual to complete full application and coordinate any reasonable on-going services per eligibility and court requirements.
